

## **Available Naming Opportunities in the Secchia Center**

### **Anatomy Teaching Suite**

#### **Sixth Floor**

---

An essential and defining feature in early medical education is human anatomy. The Secchia Center will contain laboratory space especially designed for teaching this core subject to each medical student who begins his or her course of study in West Michigan. Moreover, the College will work closely with Grand Valley State University to develop an innovative approach to this subject that will involve the various allied health professions.

#### **Third Floor**

---

The third floor is highly visible, as it is adjacent to the third floor bridge to Building 25. This floor will be frequently visited by students and faculty.

#### **Entrance Plaza**

---

The Entrance Plaza is a large outdoor area immediately adjacent to the east side of Secchia Center. This will be the area where people will enter the building from Michigan Street. This area will include a circular drive for vehicles.

#### **Fourth Floor**

---

#### **Prosection Teaching Laboratory**

---

The Prosection Teaching Laboratory is the main component of the Anatomy Teaching Suite. This is the area where students perform examination and limited dissection of various parts of the human anatomy, rather than whole bodies.

### **Plastination Laboratory**

---

The Plastination Laboratory is part of the Anatomy Teaching Suite. Plastination is a process for preserving organic material by replacing water and fat with silicon. Plastinated materials are safe, odorless, and durable. They are therefore an efficient means for teaching anatomy, although working with actual tissue is still essential. The lab for preparing plastinated materials, however, is a highly dangerous environment that requires special preparation and equipment to make it safe.

### **Arcade**

---

The Arcade will house a variety of simulation and virtual reality trainers that will provide medical students the opportunity to hone specialized procedural skills, such as injection, suturing, and intubation.

### **Second Floor**

2 naming opportunities available for the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 1 is remaining

### **Student Affairs/Admissions Suite**

2 naming opportunities available to name this space, 1 is remaining

---

This is a highly visible area adjacent to the third floor bridge to Building 25. Students and faculty will frequently visit this space.

### **Pre-Clinical Education Suite (2 opportunities)**

2 naming opportunities are available to name this space

---

This suite will house offices for the administrative arm of the college that deals with the first two years of medical school across our multi-campus system.

### **Large Computer Testing Center**

---

Increasingly, testing in the area of medical education is conducted on-line. This space will contain a large number of computers dedicated to this task.

### **Dean's Suite**

4 naming opportunities are available to name this space, 3 are remaining

---

The Secchia Center will become the new home for the Dean of the College of Human Medicine. It will be the only such home for a Michigan State University Dean outside of East Lansing. The Dean's Suite will be the administrative center of the College, housing not only the Dean, but also the Associate Deans of Research and of Academic Affairs.

### **Large Classrooms**

3 Large Classrooms, 2 naming opportunities still available

The large classrooms will hold up to 40 individuals.

### **Large Seminar Rooms**

2 Large Seminar Rooms are available naming opportunities

---

The large seminar rooms will hold up to 18 people.

### **Prosection Preparation Lab**

---

This lab is located within the Anatomy Teaching Suite. In this lab bodies are prepared and dissected by professional staff for student examination in the Prosection Teaching Lab.

### **Willed-Body Lab**

---

This lab is located within the Anatomy Teaching Suite and is where the bodies donated for medical use are stored and prepared.

### **Student Waiting/Lounge**

---

During Clinical Skills training the medical students frequently "examine" actors who play the role of patients. It is crucial, for effective teaching that the medical student and "patient" do not interact before or after this simulated encounter. Therefore, each group requires a separate waiting area.

### **Reception/Waiting Area**

---

This is the room where the actors who are playing the role of patients are greeted before they enter the Standardized Patient Waiting Room.

### **Small Computer Testing Center**

---

Increasingly, testing in the area of medical education is conducted on-line. This space will contain computers dedicated to this task.

### **Small Seminar Rooms**

---

10 Small Seminar Rooms, 9 naming opportunities still available

The small seminar rooms will hold up to 12 people.

### **Conference Rooms**

---

4 Conference Rooms, 2 naming opportunities still available

The conference rooms will hold from 10 to 12 people.

This is a large space on the third floor near many seminar rooms. The Study Alcove is enclosed on three sides and will become a prized area for studying.

### **Men's Locker Room**

Changing room for students in conjunction with the Anatomy Lab.

### **Women's Locker Room**

---

Changing room for students in conjunction with the Anatomy Lab.

### **Group Study Rooms (10 opportunities, 3 remaining)**

10 Group Study Rooms, 3 naming opportunities still available

These are 4-person room designed for group study on collaborative assignments.
